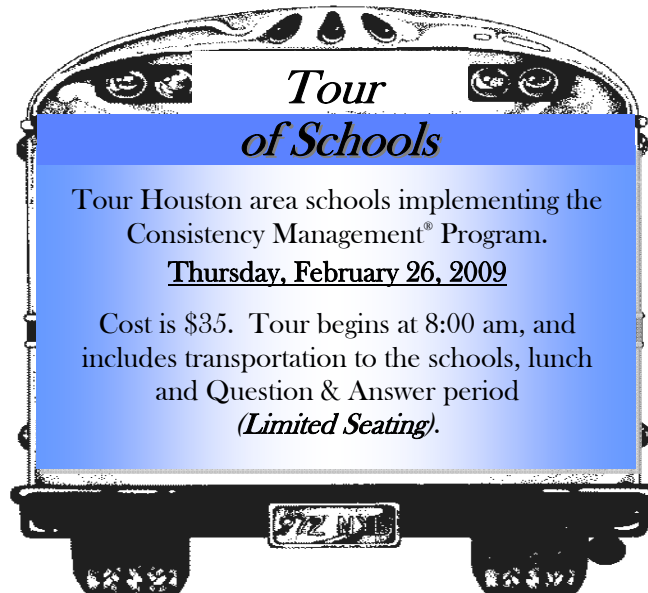

Dr. H. Jerome Freiberg, a thought-provoking and dynamic speaker, has extensive experience teaching at-risk students at the elementary and secondary levels.

Dr. Freiberg has gained international recognition with 8 books and more than one-hundred publications. Dr. Freiberg is the editor of the *Journal of Classroom Interaction*, an international journal with subscribers in over forty nations and a John & Rebecca Moore's professor in the College of Education at the University of Houston.

Dr. Freiberg is the past president of the American Education Research Association Classroom Management Special Interest Group. He published *Freedom to Learn*, the 3rd edition with psychologist Carl Rogers that was selected by the Russian Academy of Education and the Soros Foundation for translation and distribution throughout Russia. *Freedom to Learn* has also been translated to Chinese, Japanese and Spanish.

Dr. Freiberg was the senior evaluator for the Houston READ Commission 10 Year Evaluation for the Houston Mayor's Office. He was a keynote speaker at the World Congress in Psychotherapy in Vienna, Austria. He is in constant demand throughout the country to speak about classroom management and school climate.
